

# Contacting Derbyshire Constabulary

**999** The 999 number should only be used in an emergency where you need immediate help from the police. This includes situations where life is in danger or a crime is in progress or about to be committed.

**101** Use 101 24 hours a day for matters which don't require an urgent response, such as reporting a crime which has already taken place, or giving the police information about crime in your area.

If you are deaf, hard of hearing or speech impaired our non-emergency SMS number is 07800 002414.
