Bolsover Woodlands Enterprise Restore the Nature Reserve Area on Brackenfield Green

As part of the Heritage Project and with the backing of the PC, Brackenfield Village Association engaged this local Social Enterprise group to carry out flailing some of the bramble, coppicing hazel and dogwood, cutting back the willow that was overhanging the path and thinning some of the trees to allow others to mature. They brought in their chipper, chainsaws and brush cutters. The resultant chippings were laid on the path to help improve the surface and some piles of logs and brush cuttings were left to provide habitat for wildlife and to rot down, benefitting the soil.

Can you spare a little time to help keep the woodland in good shape?

It is over twenty years since the Parish Council planted this area and it was in need of a good sort out. Now that the woodland is in better condition, we can plant some snowdrops and bluebells and keep on top of any new bramble growth so the path is kept clear for all to enjoy and the area can thrive with more light and new growth. The work was funded with some of the Heritage Group grant provided by Derbyshire County Council's Community Leadership Programme. Bolsover Woodlands Enterprise was established over twenty years ago and they work widely throughout the surrounding area. Skilled professional staff train and supervise a group of adult volunteers, all of whom have learning difficulties of one kind or another. Their expertise and diligence is impressive. We hope to bid for a Lottery grant to improve some parts of Brackenfield's footpaths.
