Linda will ask if the organisers would like to join in our summer event and sell drinks and cakes in the hall from 1pm to 4.30pm, keeping the proceeds for the school/charity and paying a contribution (say £25) towards the hire of the hall.

We discussed music and agreed to ask Two Tones if they are still available. Two other vocalists have been recommended and Christine will contact them if Two Tones are booked.

Mike has booked the bins. Christine will book the Hall and Event First Aid.

It was agreed that it would be good to combine the picnic with the Trail launch to maximise attendance. This can be advertised widely e.g. Derbyshire and walking magazines, local walking groups, radio, DCC/NEDDC magazines. It would be good to invite grant funders (Tesco and DCC) and those who have assisted with the development of the Trail.IOt would be possible to set up an exhibition in the Hall and a Keynote presentation showing the Trail for those who cannot or do not choose to do the walk.
